ROGER FISHER was born in 1919 at Dover into a naval family. He was educated at Clifton College and in January 1937 joined the Royal Navy as a Special Entry Cadet, spending his first eight years at sea. In 1950 he qualified as a Barrister. His principal later appointments include: Command of HMS JUFAIR (at Bahrain) in 1957; Commander (S) of ARK ROYAL 1961; Deputy Secretary, Chiefs of Staff Committee 1965; Chief Naval Judge Advocate 1967; and, after studying at the Imperial Defence College, his last appointment was in command of HMS PEMBROKE, Chatham, in 1971. He was awarded the Distinguished Service Cross in 1944, the Cravat of the Order of the Cloud and Banner (China) in 1948 and made C.B.E. in 1973.

Captain Fisher retired from the Royal Navy in 1973 and decided to combine part-time legal appointments – first as a deputy Circuit Judge and latterly as Chairman of the Industrial Tribunals – with a painting career. He and his wife have recently moved to Suffolk where he is now painting full-time but he goes to sea in search of subjects whenever opportunity offers.

He is a member of the Royal Society of Marine Artists, the Wapping Group of Artists, the Armed Forces Art Society and the East Anglian Group of Marine Artists, as well as being a Fellow of the Royal Society of Arts. His commissions include a painting of the Silver Jubilee Fleet Review commissioned by the Board of Admiralty, now hanging in HMY BRITANNIA, and others for Trinity House, Everards, Yarrow Shipbuilders, and Naval Messes.

Thank you for your note of 4 January to which you append a list of gifts made by the Prime Minister during her recent round the world tour.

Unfortunately I am a little confused and I am writing in the hope that you will be able to clarify the position.

At the Foreign and Commonwealth Office's request we paid The Glasshouse £1,176.20 for 43 engraved and gift wrapped paper weights for the Economic Summit. We had assumed, as we had no other information, that all 43 had been presented during the course of the Summit. I assume that the 9 taken on the round the world tour were part of the Economic Summit order. I should be grateful for your confirmation that my assumption is correct. If it is, are there any more being held in stock? If, on the other hand, these 9 paper weights are a repeat order, we have not received a further bill for them (from Ian Davies).

Also in connection with the Economic Summit we paid GOODES for 15 Ducks, 15 Turtles and 8 Rabbits and WEDGEWOOD for 140 Jasper Boxes. Were all of these items presented at the Economic Summit or are any left in stock?

We have no record of paying a bill for the 6 books listed at the bottom of page 1 of the gift list. Has the bill gone astray? Could you look into it please?

Finally, to end on a happier note we have already reimbursed Mrs Crawford for the chocolates and the Halcyon Enamel Box.

The British Parliamentary hosts for this visit have informed us that, in the usual way, they will be exchanging gifts with the Soviet delegation. We have considered whether it would be appropriate for British Ministers to do so too.

Given that in formal terms the visit is a Parliamentary one, and given the number of British Ministers who will be meeting and entertaining Mr Gorbachev, we consider it would be preferable for us to make clear in advance to the Russians that we do not envisage exchanges of gifts at the various Ministerial meetings. We do not think that this would cause any offence. The Russians would understand that this is our normal practice, and the quality of the programme that has been arranged for Mr Gorbachev is already a very clear indication of our interest in and support for the visit.
