VISIT OF PRIME MINISTER ON 20 JANUARY


1. Further to my two minutes of 18 January, the Elysée have come back to us again requesting a further 15 minute delay in the Prime Minister's arrival at the Elysée Palace tomorrow, ie 1300 instead of 1245. (This is because of President Mitterrand's attendance at Charles Hernu's funeral in Lyons tomorrow morning and the subsequent possibility that he might not arrive back at the Elysée much before 1245.)
2. The Prime Minister's arrival time at Villacoublay will now be 15 minutes later than planned, ie approximately 1220. She will spend about 15 minutes (1240-1255) at the Embassy before continuing to the Elysée Palace.
3. For ease of reference, I attach a further revised programme and transport plan.

OUR TELS NOS 65 AND 71 AND TELECON GREENSTOCK/POWELL: VISIT OF PRIME MINISTER: 20 JANUARY

1. ELYSEE PALACE HAVE REQUESTED THAT THE ARRIVAL OF THE PRIME MINISTER AT THE ELYSEE PALACE TOMORROW SHOULD BE FURTHER DELAYED TO 1300.
2. PENOT (PROTOCOLE) APOLOGISED FOR THIS FURTHER DELAY AND EXPLAINED THAT MITTERRAND WISHES TO ATTEND THE FUNERAL OF FORMER DEFENCE MINISTER CHARLES HERNU WHICH WILL TAKE PLACE IN LYONS TOMORROW MORNING. IF, AS NOW SEEMS LIKELY, THE FUNERAL DOES NOT END UNTIL 1130, IT WILL BE DIFFICULT FOR THE PRESIDENT TO MAKE IT BACK TO THE ELYSEE PALACE MUCH BEFORE 1245. ACCORDING TO PENOT, A 1300 ARRIVAL BY THE PRIME MINISTER WOULD ENSURE THAT THE PRESIDENT WAS WAITING TO RECEIVE HER.
3. AS AGREED WITH NO 10 (TELECON GREENSTOCK/POWELL), ARRIVAL TIME AT VILLACOUBLAY WILL NOW BE APPROXIMATELY 1220 AND THE PRIME MINISTER WILL SPEND 15 MINUTES OR SO AT THE EMBASSY BEFORE CONTINUING TO THE ELYSEE PALACE.


