OUR TELS NOS 65 AND 71 AND TELECON GREENSTOCK/POWELL: VISIT OF PRIME MINISTER: 20 JANUARY

- 1. ELYSEE PALACE HAVE REQUESTED THAT THE ARRIVAL OF THE PRIME MINISTER AT THE ELYSEE PALACE TOMORROW SHOULD BE FURTHER DELAYED TO 1300.
- 2. PENOT (PROTOCOLE) APOLOGISED FOR THIS FURTHER DELAY AND EXPLAINED THAT MITTERRAND WISHES TO ATTEND THE FUNERAL OF FORMER DEFENCE MINISTER CHARLES HERNU WHICH WILL TAKE PLACE IN LYONS TOMORROW MORNING. IF, AS NOW SEEMS LIKELY, THE FUNERAL DOES NOT END UNTIL 1130, IT WILL BE DIFFICULT FOR THE PRESIDENT TO MAKE IT BACK TO THE ELYSEE PALACE MUCH BEFORE 1245. ACCORDING TO PENOT, A 1300 ARRIVAL BY THE PRIME MINISTER WOULD ENSURE THAT THE PRESIDENT WAS WAITING TO RECEIVE HER.
- 3. AS AGREED WITH NO 10 (TELECON GREENSTOCK/POWELL), ARRIVAL TIME AT VILLACOUBLAY WILL NOW BE APPROXIMATELY 1220 AND THE PRIME MINISTER WILL SPEND 15 MINUTES OR SO AT THE EMBASSY BEFORE CONTINUING TO THE ELYSEE PALACE.


