Two of our most tiresome subscribers over the years have been the Anglo-Israel Bank and Warburgs. Do you have personal contacts with either of them?

Anglo-Israel came in through Sir Henry d'Avigdor-Goldsmid at 25 gns. in 1965 and struggled up to £50 in February 1973.

Warburgs came in through Ronnie Grierson in 1963 at £100 and kept going at that level until October 1972.
