COMPETITIVENESS AND THE EXCHANGE RATE

The Chancellor was grateful for your submission of 16 February setting out your reservations about the thesis contained in the paper by a Treasury Working Group circulated under cover of Sir Douglas Wass' minute of 1 December.

- 2. He has commented that your note reinforces the doubts which led him to conclude against any presumption in favour of publication of the original papers, and confirms the view he then expressed that the Working Group's paper looked like a post-mortem on a patient who ought to be dead but isn't!
- 3. He would like the areas of doubts identified in paragraph 5 of Sir Douglas's minute of 1 December, 1980 to be fundamentally re-assessed in the light of your note.
