MY TELEGRAM NO 248 : AFGHANISTAN : SITREP.

- 1. A SPECIAL ENVOY FROM PRESIDENT CEAUCESCU OF ROMANIA HAS BEEN IN KABUL FOR 2 DAYS AND HAD TALKS WITH BABRAK, DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER KESHTMAND AND FOREIGN MINISTER DOST. THE VISIT IS GIVING RISE TO SPECULATION THAT SOME ROMANIAN INITIATIVE OVER AFGHANISTAN IS UNDER CONSIDERATION.
- THE SIXTY-FIRST ANNIVERSARY OF INDEPENDENCE WAS CELEBRATED ON 19 AUGUST. BABRAK'S SPEECH SAID THAT BRITISH IMPERIALISM HAD NOW BEEN REPLACED BY AMERICAN IMPERIALISM AND REPEATED THE PROMISE THAT THE LIMITED CONTINGENT OF SOVIET TROOPS WOULD BE WITHDRAWN WHEN SUITABLE GUARANTEES OF NON-INTERFERENCE WERE GIVEN. A DISPLAY OF CAPTURED WEAPONS WAS PUT ON AND A STATEMENT MADE ACCUSING THE US, BRITAIN, CHINA AND OTHER REACTIONARIES OF USING PAKISTAN AS A BASE FOR UNDECLARED WAR AGAINST AFGHANISTAN AND OF USING CHEMICAL WEAPONS.

- 3. THERE ARE RELIABLE REPORTS OF HEAVY SHELLING BY SOVIET/
 AFGHAN FORCES FROM THE EARLY HOURS OF 20 AUGUST ONWARDS AROUND
 THE VILLAGE OF SHAKADARA, SOME 20 KMS NORTH OF KABUL, AND FROM
 THERE FURTHER NORTH THROUGH MIR BACCHAKOT TO BAGRAM. THIS
 AREA HAS BEEN THE SCENE OF FIGHTING SEVERAL TIMES OVER THE
 LAST FEW WEEKS (MY TELEGRAM NO 219).
