Community with a grave crisis.  
We will have to solve it together.  
I intend to continue to work within

But first I must consult my colleagues in  
London about this situation and  
about the British Government's  
future course of action.

Pending such consultation, I must reserve my  
position on the other matters which  
we have discussed at this meeting  
and there can accordingly be no  
agreed conclusions.
