I TOLD HIM THAT I SHARED HIS DESIRE TO AVOID CONFLICT, AND UPGED HIM TO BE FORTHCOMING AND FLEXIBLE IN HIS NEGOTIATIONS WITH SECRETARY HAIG, WHO HAD MY FULL FAITH AND CONFIDENCE, WITHOUT MAKING SPECIFIC SUGGESTIONS FOR FURTHER STEPS TO ME, GENERAL GALTIER! PROMISED TO DEAL HONESTLY AND SERIOUSLY WITH SECRETARY HAIG.

I WOULD LIKE TO ADD THAT WE GREATLY APPRECIATE THE HOSPITALITY YOU HAVE SHOWN TO ALL DURING HIS TWO VISITS. WE ARE ALSO GRATEFUL FOR THE PECEPTIVITY YOU HAVE SHOWN TO OUR EFFORTS TO FIND A COMMON GROUND BETWEEN YOUR COUNTRY, ONE OF OUR CLOSEST ALLIES, AND ARGENTINA, WITH WHOM WE WOULD LIKE TO BE ABLE TO COOPERATE IN ADVANCING SPECIFIC INTERESTS IN THIS HEMISPHERE.
