Mr. Jimmy Savile, O.B.E. came into No. 10 today for a presentation ceremony in connection with the NSPCC.

As you may know, he is now engaged in an effort to raise £10m. for Stoke Mandeville Hospital.

He has asked the Prime Minister how he should pursue the question of tax deduction for charitable donations.

The Prime Minister has commented that, in her view, the 7 year covenant system is a considerable disincentive to those who are contemplating charitable donations and that 3 years might be a more reasonable period.

I would be grateful if you could let us have the Chancellor's reactions on this issue.
