Dear Prime Minister,

I have been asked by the Prime Minister of
Canada to convey the following message:

"Dear Prime Minister,

I would like to thank you for your
message on Rhodesia. As I have told you
personally and have repeated in public
statements since Lusaka, your contribution
to the success of the conference is
immeasurable. I have studied the consti-
tutional proposals which your government
has drafted and in my view they provide
a most positive basis for discussion at
the constitutional conference scheduled for
September 10.

Clearly the road ahead will be a
difficult one with opposing sides having
what they regard as essential and often
contradictory interests to protect. As
your government embarks on this process of
negotiation you may be assured of my con-
tinued personal support and that of my
government for your efforts to achieve a
settlement.
