Dear Prime Minister,

Thank you for your letter of June 13, 1980.

We share your concern in improving economic and industrial cooperation between our two countries. I have noted your interest in an important area of our industrial development and your support for Davy International.

Davy International and the Steel Authority of India have held a series of discussions on the project. We are not yet at the stage of drawing up plans for the proposed coastal steel plant. When we do so we shall give careful consideration to the British firm's offer.

High level exchanges between Governments are always helpful and can be of mutual benefit in further strengthening our bilateral relations.
