

PRIME MINISTER'S MEETING WITH MICHAEL MANLEY

The Prime Minister saw Michael Manley, Prime Minister of Jamaica, for an hour in the House of Commons yesterday - Lord Carrington was also present. Mr Manley was in Britain to address other meetings but took advantage of his visit to see the Prime Minister as well.

The Two Prime Ministers discussed Rhodesia and progress at the Lancaster House Conference.

We should not be drawn on details of the meeting which, for our own information, was a sensitive one. Although we are not to volunteer this, the question of a further Commonwealth initiative was not raised at last night's meeting.
