THEATRE NUCLEAR FORCES MODERNISATION.

1. TODAY'S PRESS REPORTS THAT EREZHNEV HAS SENT PERSONAL MESSAGES TO A HUMBER OF HATO LEADERS, INCLUDING THE FRG, UK, NETHERLANDS, MORNAY AMD DENMARK, RESTATING HIS OFFER TO REDUCE TROOPS, TANS AMD MISSILES (SIC) IF NATO ABANDONED MODERNISATION PLANS (UK DEL. NATO TEL NO 220 REFERS). SEEM. I.F.T. (NOT TO ALL).
2. THE WASHINGTON POST ALSO REPORTS THAT LATER THIS VEEK OAVID - AARON (DEPUTY YO BRZEZINSKI) ACCOMPANIED BY BARTHOLOMEW (STATE DEPARTHENT) AUD MC GIFFERT (DEFENSE DEPARTHEMT) WHL HOLD COHSULTATIONS WITH "TOP OFFICIALS' IN WEST GERMAAY, BRITAI', ITALY, BELGIUM AND HOLLAND. THESE CONSULTATIONS WERE SCHEDULED BEFORE THE EREZHNEV SPEECH, AHD WILL CONCENTRATE ON A THD $P$ PROHGED APPROACH: PROCEEDING WTH THE DEPLOYENT OF MEDIUM-RANOE HISSILES WHILE NECOTIATING LIMITS WITH THE RUSSIAVS ON SUCH. FORCES. THE REPORT COHCLUDES THAT "THE TARGET FIGURE OF 572 US MEDIUMRANGE NUCLEAR MISSILES IS NOT FIMAL, AND CCULD BE REDUCED IF MOSCOW SHOWS WILLINGUESS TO ENTER NEV NEGOTIATIOUS".
3. THE TA NeF. MODERNISATION ISSUE WAS PROMIUENT DURIHG THE MARK-UP DISCUSSIONS YESTERDAY ON SALT II IN THE SENATE FOREIGN RELATIONS COMMITTEE. AFTER (ANTI-TREATY) HELMG ARGUED THAT THE SENATE SHOULD TAKE MORE TIME IN CONSIDERING THE ISSUES, AND WAS SUPPGRTED EY GLENM, RAMKING REPUBI.ICAN JAVITS URGED THAT THERE WAS A NEED TO MOVE QUICKLY SINCE "THE WESTERN ALLIANCE IS IN gRAVE PERIL." IF THE SEHATE HAD NOT ACTED OH SALT II BY THE TIME NATO MET IN DECEMBER TO CONSIDER T. H.F. MODERHISATION, THE NECESSARY DECISIOHS MIGHT NOT BE TAKEN. "IF THEY MAKE A DECISlON AGAINST US AT THAT TIME, YOU'LL BE MIGHTY SORRY THAT YOU DIDH'T RUSH' J JAVITS ARGUED.

La THIS BROUGHT A RESPONSE FROM MINORITY LEADER BAKER, THAT THE LESIRES OF ALLSED COUNTRIES SHOULD NOT BE PERMITTED TO DETERAINE THE SEHATE'S SCHEDULE. (PRO-TREATY) BIDEH REPLIED HEATEDLY THAT IT WAS NOT THE NEEDS OF THE ALLIES BUT "OUR NAKED SELF-WHTEREST', THAT ARGUED FOR SPEEDY ACTION ON SALT. HE DEVELOPED THE THESIS, NOW GAINIHG GROUND IN WASHIHGTON, THAT DEFEAT OF SALT CCULD WELL CAUSE THE COLLAPSE OF THE DELICATELY BALANCED PLAN TO MODERNISE TOH.F.. AND PERHAPS THE UNRAVELLING OF THE ALLIANCE, GIVEN THE ALLIES' DESIRE TO SALT APPROVED AS A SIGN THAT ARMS COMTROL EFFORTS WOULD CORTINUE, THIS ARGUMENT WAS DESCRIBED BY HELAS AS "POPPY-COCK".
