A meeting of Ministers began at 0915. Present: Prime Minister, Lord Carrington, Lord Privy Seal Chancellor of the Exchequer and the Secretaries of State for Energy and Trade. At 1030 the Prime Minister was receiving a courtesy call from Bishop Muzorewa. At 1115 Joshus Nkomo and Robert Mugabe will be making a similar courtesy call. At noon the Prime Minister will attend the signing ceremony of the Lancaster House Agreement. There is a likelihood of a meeting of Ministers later this afternoon.
