Vance-Brown-Brzezinski Luncheon

The following decisions were taken at our luncheon on Wednesday:

- -- Royal Ulster Constabulary: Cy will be sending you a paper on the sale of small weapons to the British for the Constabulary. Cy will stress Speaker O'Neill's high interest in the issue and probably will recommend that you resolve the issue with this concern in mind. Cy will suggest that he brief O'Neill.
- -- Land Attack SLCM's: We agreed that conventional SLCM's should be in the Defense budget.
- -- Egyptian Defense Industry: With respect to military assistance, we agreed that the foreign assistance budget meeting will be used by Cy and Harold to raise the issue of FMS for Egypt directly with you. With respect to the Egyptian defense industry itself, we agreed that the PD exception should be limited to enhancement of I-Hawk spare parts production.
- -- Pakistan Nuclear Problem: We agreed to discuss this at the PRC on South Asian nuclear matters, which is being rescheduled.
- -- Defense Assistance Stockpile: We agreed to leave the budget figure as it stands for FY 81. The remainder (\$450 million) is to be in the remainder of the five year program 1982-1985.



- -- FY 81 IMET Levels: We all agreed to support \$33 million as the required minimum.
- -- Response to Brezhnev Message on Threat Assessment: We agreed on the text of a response to Brezhnev's message on last week's NORAD computer error. We also agreed that the response should be delivered as a U.S. oral message to the Soviet government rather than a message from you.
