CHARGE MET ON NOVEMBER 4

REGARDING REPORTS FROM BONN OF A UK-FRG-FRENCH WORKING GROUP ON ARMS CONTROL ISSUES. THERE DENIE
THERE WAS ANY TRUTH TO THE STORIES, EITHER REPORTS
THAT WE HAVE RECEIVED FROM OFFICIALS IN BONN OR THE DENIED MONDAY ARTICLE THAT APPEARED IN THE WALL STREET
JOURNAL. WITH A LAUGH, SAID WE COULD IMAGINE
THE WRATH OF THE FCO HAD THEY DISCOVERED A SEPARATE
FOREIGN POLICY EMANATING FROM NUMBER 18.

3. WAS AT A LOSS AS TO THE BASIS FOR THE STORIES. HE SAID THAT AN FCO CABLE REPORTING ON THE FRANCO-GERMAN SUMMIT IN FRANKFURT LAST WEEK HAD MENTIONED THAT THE FRENCH AND GERMANS HAD AGREED TO INITIATE AN ANALYTICAL STUDY ON ARMS CONTROL IN EUROPE WITH A THOUGHT POSSIBLY OF INVITING THE-BRITISH TO PARTICIPATE. ALSO MENTIONED THAT WHEN MITTERRAND HAD LUNCHED WITH MRS. THATCHER IN LONDON TWO WEEKS AGO, THEY HAD DISCUSSED THE IMMEDIATE RESULTS OF REYKJAVIK AND HAD AGREED THAT IMMEDIATE RESULTS OF REYXJAVIK AND HAD AGREED THAT THEIR CONCERNS SHOULD BE PASSED ON TO KOHL PRIOR TO THE CHANCELLOR'S VISIT TO WASHINGTON.
