2. THE SECRETARY CALLED IN ARGENTINE AMBABSADOR TAKACS AT 7:45 P.M., APRIL 1. THEY MET FOR 15 MINUTES, WITH ARA DAS BOSWORTH ALSO PRESENT. THE SECRETARY TOLD TAKACS THAT THE PRESIDENT AND HE ARE DEEPLY CONCERNED ABOUT THE SITUATION IN THE SOUTH ATLANTIC. OUR ASSESSMENT SUGGESTS THAT THE USE OF FORCE IS CONTEMPLATED ON THE FALKLAND ISLANDS AND IN SOUTH GENORIA AS WELL, HE KNOW THAT THE UK WILL TAKE A COUNTER ACTION IF THIS HAPPENS. THE SITUATION WOULD BECOME A TRAGEDY. MOTHING WOULD BE MORE SELF DEFEATING FOR ARGENTINA'S INTEREST IN GOOD RELATIONS WITH THE UNITED STATES. 3. THE SECRETARY SAID HE HAD BEEN IN TOUCH WITH LOED CARRINGTON AND RECEIVED THE CLEAR IMPRESSION THE ERITISH WILL REACT. HE SAID HE HAD URGED THE PRESIDENT TO CALL GALTIERI.
