1. AFTER THE MEETING WITH PRESIDENT NYERERE, MR MLOKA, PRINCIPAL SECRETARY MFA WHO HAD BEEN PRESENT, SPOKE TO ME. 

- 1. I WAS SUMMONED THIS MORNING 12 JANUARY BY PRESIDENT NYERERE ALONG WITH THE OTHER COMMONWEALTH REPRESENTATIVES
- P. NYERERE EXPRESSED HIS SHOCK AND PROTEST AT THE KILLING
 BY THE RHODESIAN SECURITY FORCES ACTING UNDER THE GOVERNOR'S
 AUTHORITY OF A NUMBER OF PATRIOTIC FRONT FORCES WHO WERE ON
 THEIR WAY TO AN ASSEMBLY POINT, AS REPORTED ON THE BBC. THIS
 WAS MURDER, AND EVEN MORE SHOCKING THAN THE KILLING WAS THE
 COVERNOR'S ATTEMPT TO JUSTIFY IT. THERE WAS NO QUESTION IN
 THIS CASE OF A BREACH OF THE CEASEFIRE, AND EVEN IF THERE HAD
 BEEN, THE GOVERNOR SHOULD USE PEOPLE OF THE SAME PARTY TO
 DEAL WITH IT. AND WHAT WAS THE MONITORING FORCE DOING WHEN
 THIS HAPPENED?

3. NYERERE CONCLUDED THAT HE DID NOT KNOW WHAT TO DO. HE HAD NEVER BELIEVED THAT THE BRITISH WERE GOING TO PRESIDE OVER MORE KILLINGS PERPETRATED BY THE SAME RACIST REBELS. THE SITUATION WAS FAR WORSE THAN IN 1965. THEN WE HAD JUST FAILED TO ACT: NOW WE WERE CONTINUING THE KILLING. 4. I SAID THAT THE GOVERNOR HAD EXPRESSED HIS REGRET AT THESE DEATHS WHICH I KNEW MY GOVERNMENT FULLY SHARED. I EXPLAINED THE REQUIREMENT THAT PF FORCES COMING IN AFTER THE DEADLINE WERE REQUIRED TO GIVE UP THEIR ARMS. 5. NYERERE REPEAT HIS SHOCK AT ATTEMPTS TO JUSTIFY THE KILLING. ADDRESSING PARTICULARLY THE AUSTRALIAN HIGH COMMISSIONER HE PRESSED AGAIN RHETORICALLY TO KNOW WHAT THE MONITORING FORCE WAS DOING. 6. THE CANADIAN HIGH COMMISSIONER EXPRESSED HIS GOVERNMENT'S WISH TO SEE PROGRESS TOWARDS THE HOLDING OF THE ELECTIONS. NYERERE SEIZED THE OPPORTUNITY TO REPEAT HIS COMPLAINT THAT THE ZANU POLITICAL LEADERSHIP WAS STILL BEING KEPT OUT OF RHODESIA.

HE ALLEGED THAT THE ZANU DIRECTOR OF ELECTIONS WAS STILL IN MAPUTO UNABLE TO TRAVEL TO SALISBURY WHEN THERE WERE ELECTION DOCUMENTS WHICH HAD TO BE FILED WITH THE AUTHORITIES ON MONDAY.
