COS 47TH MEETING/82 HELD ON MONDAY 10 MAY 1982 AT 12.15 pm

- SIR TERENCE LEWIN invited the Deputy Chief of the Defence Staff (Intelligence) to update them on current
- LIEUTENANT GENERAL GLOVER (Deputy Chief of the Defence Staff (Intelligence)) reviewed the intelligence published in the latest summary (1).

4. MR McDONALD (Deputy Chief of Public Relations) reported on Press coverage. In subsequent discussion the point was made that the capture of the NARWAL the previous day had highlighted the difficulties of obtaining early and accurate reports from the Task Force. The Chief of Public Relations was due to report by 5 pm that day on ways in which the system of reporting incidents and passing information rapidly to the Press could be improved. A major aspect would be to determine where and how the necessary security control could be imposed.

 - To instruct the Assistant Chief of the Defence Staff (Operations), in conjunction with the Deputy Chief of Public Relations, to prepare a draft statement for release to the Press in the event that a surface ship engaged an Argentine Boeing 707 aircraft under the new Rules of Engagement which should include details of the tracks of previous
 - as soon as possible suitable members for the panel
