THEREFORE SINCE I WILL NOT HAVE THE CAUSE AND SUFFERINGS OF MY PEOPLE SLIGHTED IN THIS WAY I WILL NOT BE TAKING UP YOUR OFFER OF A FIFTEEN MINUTE MEETING. IF YOU CAN SPARE OVER ONE HOUR TO HEAR THE VIEWS OF THE ROMAN CATHOLIC COMMUNITY THEN THE VIEWS OF THE PROTESTANTS SHOULD BE REGARDED AS JUST AS IMPORTANT AND TREATED AS SUCH. THOUGH AT THIS TIME YOU HAVE CHOSEN NOT TO HEAR ADEQUATELY THE VIEWS OF ULSTER LOYALISTS YOU MOST CERTAINLY WILL HEAR THOSE VIEWS NEXT WEDNESDAY THROUGH THE BALLOT BOX. YOURS SINCERELY.
