YOUR TEL MODEV 502: GUJARAT DAM DISASTER

1. I HAVE THIS MORNING PASSED THE QUEEN'S MESSAGE TO THE
PRESIDENT. WE ARE ISSUING A PRESS RELEASE CONTAINING THE MESSAGE.

- 2. I AGREE A MESSAGE OF SYMPATHY FROM THE GOVERNMENT WOULD ALSO
 BE APPROPRIATE. I SUGGEST THAT THE MESSAGE SHOULD BE FROM
 THE PRIME MINISTER AS I BELIEVE CHARAN SINCH WOULD APPRECIATE THIS.
 HOWEVER, SPEED IS PERHAPS MORE IMPORTANT, AND IF AN IMMEDIATE
 MESSAGE FROM THE PRIME MINISTER CANNOT BE AUTHORISED I SUGGEST
 A MESSAGE FROM THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO MISHRA. I SUGGEST THE
 FOLLOWING DRAFT:
- " I WAS GREATLY SADDENED TO HEAR OF THE LOSS OF LIFE AND DAMAGE CAUSED BY THE DAM DISASTER IN GUJARAT. PLEASE ACCEPT MY SYMPATHY. WE STAND READY TO PROVIDE RELIEF SUPPLIES IF NEEDED".

PLEASE LET US KNOW AS SOON AS POSSIBLE IF WE CAN PASS SUCH A MESSAGE.

- 3. MINISTERS MAY WISH TO BE AWARE THAT WE BELIEVE THERE MAY BE SEVERAL HUNDRED UK PASSPORT HOLDERS IN THE AFFECTED AREA. WE SHALL REPORT AGAIN ON THIS WHEN THINGS ARE CLEARER.
- 4. SEE MIF MODEY TELEGRAM ON THE EXTENT OF THE DISASTER AS NOW KNOWN.
