Dear Prime Minister,

I wish first of all to congratulate you on your recent victory at the polls and for the clear mandate which has been given to your government.

On 29 December, 1979, I wrote to your predecessor in office inviting him to attend the celebration of the 250th Anniversary of Parliament in The Bahamas in September, 1979. Mr. Callaghan was kind enough to accept the invitation and I should now like to renew that invitation to you as Prime Minister.

Details of the programme are not yet available, but the main events will be spread over a period of one week climaxing with the formal opening of a new Session of Parliament on the anniversary date, the 29 September, and with a Service of Thanksgiving on the 30 September.

I hope you will be able to come. It would be a pleasure to welcome you to The Bahamas.
