## HIGHLY CONFIDENTIAL

- 1. Less government. Less legislation. Systematic pruning of existing secondary legislation. Aim to cut government share of G.N.P. from 63% to 40% in two parliaments - so as to slash inflation, borrowing and taxation. Work towards a balanced Budget.
- 2. Inflation and unemployment: trades unions can abate unemployment - by wage restraint: by less overmanning and restrictive practice so as to make us more competitive and thus provide more jobs than are lost. Government and government only can abate inflation.
- 3. The process of prosperity and enterprise: innovation: the need to back successes if there are to be jobs for those redeployed from over-manning, change and failure.
- 4. Immigration
