My Secretary of State is meeting the Convention of Scottish Local Authorities at 2 pm this Friday, 16 November, to announce our rate support grant settlement. He will be announcing at the same time the detailed implications for Scottish programmes of the public expenditure decisions that have been taken for 1980-81.

He intends to inform the House of the substance of his announcements by means of arranged Questions and Answers on Monday (he cannot, unlike DOE, lay the Answers on Friday because the meeting with COSLA does not take place until Friday afternoon).

BACKGROUND NOTE

Since the Scottish figures underlying the totals in Cmnd 7746 were provided, some small further adjustments have been made to outturn etc. figures, particularly for 1978-79 and 1979-80. To that extent the figures in the Table are not exactly compatible with those underlying Table 2 in Cmnd 7746 but the second sentence of the reply should cover this point without undue emphasis. (The changes in genral marginally improve the position of 1980-81 relative to previous years). There have been no changes, however, in the figures for the key year, 1980-81.
