PLEASE ARRANGE DELIVERY OF THE FOLLOWING MESSAGE FROM THE PRIME MINISTER TO PRESIDENT ZIA A S A P. BEGINS:

DURING LORD CARRINGTON'S TALKS WITH YOU ON 15 JANUARY, YOU DISCUSSED THE PROBLEMS PAKISTAN HAD FACED SINCE AFGHANISTAN'S THADITIONAL NEUTRAL STATUS HAD BEEN ERODED. WE HAVE HAD YOUR REMARKS MUCH IN MIND DURING THE WORK WE HAVE BEEN DOING ON THE PROBLEM IN RECENT WEEKS. I THOUGHT IT WOULD BE RIGHT TO TELL YOU THAT THEY HAVE BEEN AN IMPORTANT INFLUENCE ON THE WORK WE HAVE BEEN DOING.

WE ARE TELLING THE RUSSIANS THAT IN OUR VIEW THE INTERESTS OF WORLD STABILITY AND OF FRUITFUL EAST/WEST RELATIONS WOULD BE GREATLY ADVANCED BY AN AGREED SCLUTION TO THE CONTINUING PROBLEM IN AFGHANISTAN. THAT GOUNTRY HAS TRADITIONALLY BEEN NEUTRAL, THE SOVIET UNION HAS APPROVED ITS NEUTRALITY, FOR INSTANCE IN CCTOBER 1963 MR BREZEMBY SAID: QUOTE IN THE SOVIET UNION THE POLICY OF NEUTRALITY AND NO PARTICIPATION IN MILITARY BLOCS PURSUED BY AFGHANISTAN IS HIGHLY VALUED. THANKS TO THIS POLICY AFGHANISTAN WAS GREATLY RESPECTED IN THE WORLD. UNQUOTE.

WE HAVE NOTED THE SOVIET UNION'S EXPRESSIONS OF CONCERN ABOUT SECURITY ON ITS SOUTHERN BORDER AND THE SOVIET POSITION, PESTATED BY PRESIDENT BREZHARY IN HIS SPEECH ON 22 PERBURRY, THAT SOVIET FORCES WILL WITHDRAW ONCE THE CLAIMED REASONS FOR THEIR PRESENCE NO LONGER EXIST. WE HAVE ALSO NOTED MY GROMYKO'S STATEMENT ON IN FERNANCY THAT THERE ARE QUOTE NO MAJOR INTERNATIONAL PROBLEMS UNQUOTE UPON WHICH THE SOVIET UNION WOULD NOT BE READY FOR MEGOTIATIONS ON AN EQUAL BASIS. WE HAD ALSO NOTED VERY RECENT PRESS DEPORTS SUGGESTING THAT THE SOVIET GOVERNMENT MIGHT DE INTERESTED IN NEGOTIATION.

THE FLEMENTS IN A NEUTRALITY ARRANGEMENT MIGHT INCLUDE PRESIDENT BREZHNEV'S SPEECH OF 22 FEBRUARY, BY THE UNITED STATES AND THE NEIGHBOURS OF AFGHANISTAN, AND PERHAPS OTHER COUNTRIES. THAT
