Activities

Worked part in your briefing to Stanford group. ~~After you left, the first question they asked me was, "What is Z.B. really like?"~~ They also showed some interest in Robert Mugabe, Julius Nyerere, and that crowd. (U)

Worked with State on options paper for the President's reply to Mrs. Thatcher on Zimbabwe. We were just about to go to press this evening, with a \$15 million package possible (stolen from here and there), -- when OMB suddenly announced that we had \$15 in 1980 funds, free and clear. I am skeptical. At any rate, we will check it out, and push for a paper for the President by cob tomorrow, or early Friday at the latest. (C)

Worked with several people trying to arrange for Mrs. Mondale to take part in a Corcoran ceremony with President Senegal on April 6/7, -- but scheduling conflicts seem to keep getting in the way. (U)
