Prime Minister

After yr. talk yesterday with Dr Caldera I am hesitant about making further suggestions for Latin American politicians: nevertheless, recalling our telephone conversation on Monday last, I report to you that Manuel Ulloa, the Prime Minister of Peru, is leaving Lima tomorrow Saturday for a meeting in Helsinki next Wednesday May 12. He is apparently travelling via Frankfurt & Brussels & cd. if you wished it, visit you either before or after that day - eg. on Tuesday or Thursday.

Manuel Ulloa is — or at least, remembering Dr Caldera's change of character from his previous rational self, appeared to me to be when last seen by me in November — a sane, prudent & widely experienced politician. He is on close personal terms with the civilian ministers in Argentina, particularly Dr Costa Mendez. His wife, from whom he is apparently separated, is an Argentinian & lives in Buenos Aires; but they are on good terms. I understood that he talks to Buenos Aires on the telephone daily.
