WEDNESDAY, 28TH JULY 1982

1. The subjects which the Executive would like you to raise are:-
  - (a) The economy
  - (b) Industrial relations
  - (c) Defence
2. Edward has suggested that you should open shortly (literally 5 minutes at the most) on each subject. There would then be a discussion on each, before we move on to the next topic.
3. At the end, Edward will raise the question of our standing with the Electorate; ie. he will ask you how you see the political situation developing, with particular reference to the next General Election.
4. In a typically rat-like speech yesterday during the Employment Debate, Edward said:-

"We should set up a National economic recovery programme and I hope that my RHF the Prime Minister will set up a small task force for that purpose; That ~~time~~ should be given a clear objective: to identify potentially profitable capital projects and to mobilise the necessary private capital to finance them."
