THE HAVE JUST NOW RECEIVED AN ARGENTINE RESPONSE WHICH THE LEFECT PEJECTS OUR PROPOSAL. WE WILL THEREFORE ISSUEDA STATES ENT FRIDAY ON OUR VIEW TOWARD THE CRISIS AND ON THE STEPS WE APE TAKING IN LIGHT OF THE ARGENTINE POSITION. I AT SUPE YOU AGREE THAT IT IS ESSENTIAL HOW TO MAKE CLEAR TO THE WORLD THAT EVERY EFFORT WAS MADE TO ACHIEVE A FAIR AND PRACEFUL SOLUTION, AND THAT THE ARGENTINE GOVERNMENT AS OFFFEED A CHOICE BETWEEN SUCH A SCLUTION AND FURTHER HUSTILITIES. WE WILL THEREFORE MAKE PUBLIC A GENERAL ACCOUNT OF THE EFFCETS WE HAVE MADE. WHILE WE WILL DESCRIBE THE U.S. PROPOSAL IN BROAD TERMS, WE WILL NOT RELEASE IT BECAUSE OF THE DIFFICULTY THAT MIGHT CAUSE YOU. I RECOGNIZE THAT WHILE YOU SEE FUMPARE (TAL DIFFICULTIES IN THE PROPOSAL, YOU HAVE NOT PEJECTED IT. WE WILL LEAVE NO DOUBT THAT HEP MAJESTY S CHOICE BUT TO PROCEED WITH MILITARY ACTION BASED ON THE RIGHT F SELF-DEFENSE. YOU HAVE MADE CLEAR THROUGHOUT THIS CRISIS THAT, WHILE YOU HAVE ANTED ABOVE ALL A PEACEFUL SETTLEMENT ON THE BASIS OF UT SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 502, YOUR GOVERNMENT WAS PPEPARED TO USE MILITARY MEANS TO REMOVE ARGENTINE FORCES FACE THE ISLANDS. WEITHER YOUR GOOD WILL IN WANTING PEACE LE YOUR READITIESS TO USE FORCE IF NECESSARY VERE EVER TH COURT. I MICH THAT YOU ARE AS SADDENED AS I THAT IT HAS NOT LEFT FUSSIBLE TO AMERT HUSTILLTIES, AND I AS THEAPTEDED THAT YOU HAVE 'ADE CLEAR THAT HO HURE THAN MINIS ESSENTIAL FURCE TILL 'E USED. IT IS AS PERCENTANT AS EVER THAT WE PRESERVE THE GROUND FOR A RECOTIATED SCLUTICY. WHILE IT PAY BE PUSSIBLE FORCIFLY TO DELEVE ARCE IT I'VE FORCES, THE FUTURE VILL BE FRAUGHT VITE E TO CE PAGE 31

INSTABILITY, ANIMOSITY, AND INSECURITY IF A MUTUALLY ACCEPTABLE FRAMEWORK FOR PEACE IS NOT ULTIMATELY FOUND. THEREFORE, WE SHOULD CONTINUE TO WORK TO SECURE A JUST PEACE. THE PARTIES TOWARD THIS END.

CUR SHARED PRINCIPLES HAVE ASSURED FROM THE GUTSET THAT WE WOULD WORK WITH COMMON PURPOSE. AS YOU KNOW, WE HAVE REFRAINED FROM TAKING THOSE ACTIONS IN DIRECT SUPPORT OF YOUR POSITION THAT WOULD HAVE MADE OUR DIPLOMATIC HISSICN IMPOSSIBLE. YOU HAVE SHOWN CLEAR UNDERSTANDING FOR OUR JUDGMENT ON THIS AND HAVE OFFERED EVERY ENCOURAGEMENT TO OUR EFFORT TO FIND A PEACEFUL SOLUTION. THIS REFLECTS THE HIGHEST DEGREE OF STATESMANSHIP AND CONFIDENCE ON YOUR PART.

THERE CAN BE NO DOUBT ABOUT OUR FULL SUPPORT FOR YOU AND THE PRINCIPLES OF INTERNATIONAL LAW AND ORDER YOU ARE THIS ISSUE IS DEBATED. YOU CAN ALSO COUNT ON CUR SYMPATHETIC CONSIDERATION OF REQUESTS FOR ASSISTANCE. WE WILL ALSO ANNOUNCE THAT ARGENTINASS REFUSAL TO WITHDRAW ITS INVASION FORCE AND TO NEGOTIATE IN GOOD FAITH HAVE MADE IT NECESSARY AIRES. AL HAIG WILL BE IN TOUCH WITH FRANCIS PYM CONCERNING THE SPECIFIC MEASURES WE WILL TAKE.

WE WILL OF COURSE WANT TO STAY IN VERY CLOSE TOUCH IN THE DAYS AND WEEKS AHEAD. I REMAIN CONVINCED THAT OUR COMBINED EFFORTS CAN YIELD A JUST SETTLEMENT WHICH WILL STRENGTHEN THE PRINCIPLES FOR WHICH WE STAND, AND I CAN ONLY REACHED.
