YOUR TELNO 1065: FALKLANDS

1. I HAVE DELIVERED YOUR MESSAGE TO HAIG WHO IS GRATEFUL FOR THIS FRANK ACCOUNT, THOUGH CERTAINLY CONCERNED ABOUT THE WAY THINGS MAY DEVELOP WHICH HE WANTS TO DISCUSS AGAIN URGENTLY WITH ME.

- 2. I AM CONSCIOUS OF A GAP BETWEEN THE MOOD IN LONDON AND OPINION HERE AND WOULD LIKE TO TRY TO DESCRIBE THIS TO YOU TOGETHER WITH ITS POSSIBLE IMPLICATIONS.
- 3. THE AMERICANS RECOGNISE THAT THE CHANGE IN THE MILITARY SCENE HAS INEVITABLY BROUGHT ABOUT A CHANGE IN OUR ATTITUDE ABOUT WITH-DRAWAL AND THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE ISLANDS. AS THEY SEE IT, WE ARE NOW INSISTING ON SURRENDER OF THE ARGENTINIAN GARRISON AND A RETURN OF BRITISH RULE WITHOUT ANY DEFINITE COMMITMENT TO AN ATTEMPT TO ACHIEVE A LONG-TERM SOLUTION - IN EFFECT WE ARE BASING

- 4. THE AMERICANS BELIEVE THAT THIS:
- A) WILL HARDEN ARGENTINIAN MILITARY RESISTANCE' IN THE SHORT AND LONGER TERM:
- B) WILL SOLIDIFY THE LATIN AMERICANS IN THEIR BACKING FOR ARGENTINA. NOT JUST NOW BUT IN THE FUTURE:
- C) WILL ENCOURAGE CONTINUED ARGENTINE HOSTILITIES AGAINST US,
 RENDERING DIFFICULT THE RESTORATION OF NORMAL LIFE ON THE ISLANDS,
 APART ALTOGETHER FROM THE DEMANDS THAT THIS WILL PLACE ON OUR
 LONG TERM DEFENCE INTERESTS:
- D) WILL HELP THE RUSSIANS TO INCREASE THEIR INFLUENCE IN LATIN AMERICA AND,
- E) PERHAPS MOST IMPORTANT OF ALL, POSE FOR THE AMERICANS THE PROBLEM OF EITHER EXACERBATING THEIR RELATIONS WITH THE WHOLE LATIN AMERICAN WORLD OR BRINGING ABOUT A DETERIORATION IN RELATIONS BETEEN THE U S AND THE UK.
- . 5. I SHOULD SAY THAT THIS INTERPRETATION IS NOT SIMPLY A REFLECTION OF THE LATIN AMERICAN LOBBY IN THE STATE DEPARTMENT OR WHITE HOUSE: IT IS, I BELIEVE, A GROWING VIEW IN THE US ADMINISTRATION AND ONE THAT IS CERTAINLY LIKELY TO BECOME MORE DOMINANT IF THINGS GO ON AS THEY ARE.
 - AT HOME ON THIS SUBJECT. BUT, IF WE ARE GOING TO KEEP THE AMERICANS WITH US, SOMETHING THAT I BELIEVE IS ESSENTIAL, WE WILL HAVE TO MAKE SOME ALLOWANCE FOR THEIR VIEWS AND INTERESTS. I DO NOT SUGGEST THAT THEY REGRET THEIR DECISION OF 30 APRIL TO COME DOWN ON OUR SIDE, BUT THEY ARE INCREASINGLY AWARE OF THE COSTS THAT THIS IS LIABLE TO INVOLVE FOR THEM.
 - 7. THERE IS OF COURSE AN IMMEDIATE NEED TO KEEP THE U.N. SECRETARY GENERAL IN PLAY AS LONG AS POSSIBLE SO AS TO AVOID ANOTHER MUCH LESS ACCEPTABLE RESOLUTION IN THE SECURITY COUNCIL. THERE IS ALSO THE PROBLEM OF THE FORTHCOMING OAS MEETING AND THE DILEMMA THAT THIS POSES FOR THE US. THERE IS FURTHERMORE THE LONG-TERM PROBLEM, WHICH AFFECTS BOTH THE UN AND OAS ISSUES, THAT I WANT TO PUT TO YOU. IF WE ARE TO SQUARE THE CIRCLE OF OUR REQUIREMENTS AND THE NEEDS OF THE AMERICANS, WE HAVE TO PRODUCE SOMETHING IN RELATION TO THE LONG-TERM STATUS OF THE ISLANDS THAT IS NOT SIMPLY A RETURN TO THE STATUS QUO ANTE, AND THAT DOES NOT LEAVE US IN INDEFINITE CONFRONTATION WITH ARGENTINA, AND HENCE LATIN AMERICA. I AM NOT HERE DEALING WITH THE ADMINISTRATION THAT FOLLOWS IMMEDIATELY THE MILITARY DEFEAT OF THE ARGENTINIAN GARRISON RECAUSE THIS WILL BE BRITISH. THIS WILL BE

WITH ARGENTINA, AND HENCE LATIN AMERICA. I AM NOT HERE DEALING WITH THE ADMINISTRATION THAT FOLLOWS IMMEDIATELY THE MILITARY DEFEAT OF LE ARGENTINIAN GARRISON BECAUSE THIS WILL BE BRITISH. THIS WILL BE A MATTER OF FACT. BUT IT WILL PRESUMABLY BE DESIRABLE AT A FAIRLY EARLY STAGE TO HAVE SOME SORT OF PEACE WITH THE ARGENTINIANS, AND IT IS HERE THAT THE LONG TERM ISSUE WILL ARISE.

- 8. SO THE QUESTION HAS TO BE FACED WHAT SORT OF PROPOSALS FOR THE FUTURE COULD WE CONSIDER PUTTING FORWARD IN THESE CIRCUMSTANCES.

 I SHOULD INTERJECT THAT EVEN IF WE OURSELVES DO NOT HAVE IDEAS ON THIS, I AM SURE THAT OTHERS ARE GOING TO START PROPOUNDING THEM:

 AND THE AMERICANS WILL TAKE THE VIEW, THAT IF WE ARE NOT PREPARED TO TACKLE THIS ASPECT A DIVERGENCE OF INTEREST WILL DEVELOP BETWEEN WASHINGTON AND LONDON. THE AMERICANS, AS YOU KNOW, INSIST THAT THE MOMENT TO ADVANCE SUCH IDEAS WILL BE WHEN WE ARE AT OUR MAXIMUM MILITARY STRENGTH.
- 9. COULD WE CONTEMPLATE SAYING, AS PART OF A PEACE OFFER, SOMETHING ON THE FOLLOWING LINES:
- A) THE FUTURE OF THE ISLANDS MUST PROVIDE FOR RETURN TO NORMAL LIFE, WHICH IN TURN PRE-SUPPOSES PROVISION FOR THEIR LONG-TERM SECURITY.
- B) THESE REQUIREMENTS COULD BE ACHIEVED BY SELF-GOVERNMENT FOR THE ISLANDERS COMBINED, FOR THE LONGER TERM, WITH SOME MEASURE OF INTERNATIONALISATION.
 - C) IN THE IMMEDIATE YEARS AHEAD THEIR DEFENCE AND FOREIGN POLICY INTERESTS SHOULD BE SAFEGUARDED BY SOME INTERNATIONAL GROUP COMPRISING SAY TWO REGIONAL POWERS, PLUS THE US AND THE UK, WITH THE PRESENCE PERHAPS OF US AND BRAZILIAN FORCES, AND
- THE ISLANDERS, MAKE PROPOSALS ABOUT THE STATUS OF THE FALKLAND
- 10. I UNDERSTAND THE DIFFICULTY OF TRYING TO FOCUS ON THIS TYPE
 OF LONG-TERM PROBLEM IN THE HEAT OF BATTLE. BUT, AS I SUGGEST, I
 BELIEVE THAT OUR MILITARY INTERESTS WILL BE AFFECTED BY IT. I AM ALSO
 WORRIED BY THE POTENTIAL SWING IN AMERICAN ATTITUDES AND CONVINCED
 THAT THE BEST WAY OF INFLUENCING THIS WILL BE BY ENTERING INTO
 DISCUSSIONS, HOWEVER INFORMAL, WITH THEM ABOUT THE FUTURE. THIS
 CANNOT AND SHOULD NOT AT THE PRESENT TIME BE AT A HIGH LEVEL, OR
 INVOLVE ANYTHING REMOTELY IN THE NATURE OF A COMMITMENT. IT IS
 SIMPLY A QUESTION OF TRYING OUT THE GROUND AND PREVENTING THE
 AMERICANS FLYING OFF WITH SOMETHING THAT IS UNWELCOME TO US.
 WHATEVER OUR RESERVATIONS, THE AMERICANS ARE EAGER TO TEST US OUT
 WITH CERTAIN SUGGESTIONS. I DO NOT ASK YOU AT THIS STAGE
