BACKGROUND AND GUIDANCE ON FALKLANDS/HALVIMAS FISHING DISPUTE

2. BACKGROUND FOR FALKLANDS/MALVINAS FISHING DISPUTE: ON OCTOBER 29, UK FOREIGN SECRETARY HOME NOTIFIED THE HOUSE OF COMMONS OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A 200 NAUTICAL MILE INTERIM FISHING CONSERVATION ZONE AROUND THE FALKLAND/MALVINAS ISLANDS. HE SAID THERE WOULD BE STRICT ENFORCEMENT WITHIN 150 WAUTION HILLES OF THE ARCHIPELAGO BEGINNING FEBRUARY 1, 1987 ITHE REGINNING OF THE SOULD FISHING SEASON). HOWE ALSO SAID THAT THE AREA WOULD BE PATROLLED BY CIVILIAN SHIPS BUT THAT THE UK HIGHT USE ARMED FORCE IN APPROPRIATE CIRCUMSTANCES TO PROTECT ITS RIGHTS.

3. THE TEXT OF THE BRITISH DECLARATION INDICATES CONTINUED BRITISH WILLINGNESS TO MEGOTIATE A MULTILATERAL FISHING ARRANGEMENT, BUT IT ALSO MAKES CLEAR THAT THE UK WILL ENFORCE THE FISHING CONSERVATION ZONE ON FEBRUARY 1, IF NECESSARY.

4. THE UK AND ARGENTINA AGREED IN 1985 TO COOPERATE IN A FAD STUDY, DUE TO BE COMPLETED IN DECEMBER 1986, ON THE DEPLETION OF FISHING RESOURCES IN THIS INTERNATIONALLY UNREGULATED AREA. IN THE INTERIM. THE GOA CONCLUDED SEPARATE BILATERAL TREATIES IN LATE JULY 1985 WITH THE USSR AND BULGARIA AND HAS SOUGHT SIMILAR TREATIES WITH OTHER MATIONS FISHING IN THOSE WATERS. HOWE CITED THESE TREATIES AS A HAJOR REASON FOR THE BRITISH DECISION TO DECLARE THE EIGHING CONSERVATION TONE

5. THE GOA VIGOROUSLY PROTESTED THE BRITISH DECISION IN A PRESS STATEMENT RELEASED ON OCTOBER 38. THE PRESS STATEMENT ROISES THE SOMEREIGHTY BISPLITE OVER THE ISLANDS AS BEING AT THE HEART OF THE PROBLEM. THE STATEMENT CONCLUDED BY ASSERTING THAT "THE ARGENTINE GOVERNMENT WILL UPHOLD ITS LEGITIMATE RIGHTS IN THE AREA. AS WELL AS O: WHAT IS THE U.S. GOVERNMENT POSITION CONCERNING THE DISPUTE SETWEEN ARGENTINA AND THE UNITED KINGDOM OVER FISHING RIGHTS IN THE AREA OF THE FALKLANDS/MALVINAS ISLANDS?

A: WE HOPE THERE WILL BE NO PRECIPITOUS ACTION BY EITHER COUNTRY. WE HAVE CONSISTENTLY URGED BOTH COUNTRIES TO RESOLVE THEIR DIFFERENCES THROUGH DIPLOMATIC MEANS. WE NNOV THAT BOTH COUNTRIES AGREE ON THE NEED FOR CONSERVATION OF THE FISHERY RESOURCES.

THE ARCA IN QUESTION IS ONE OF THE FEW UNREGIT ATED FISHING AREAS REMAINING IN THE WORLD. THERE IS A STUDY UNDERWAY ON THE DEPLETION OF FISHING RESOURCES BY THE FOOD AND AGRICULTURAL ORGANIZATION (FAD). WE HOPE THAT WITH THE PARTICIPATION OF OTHER CONCERNED NATIONS. THROUGH SUCH INTERNATIONAL DRGANIZATIONS AS THE FAO. AND WITH THE COOPERATION OF ARGENTINA AND THE UNITED KINGDOM. A REGIME WILL BE ADOPTED THAT SERVES THE COMMON INTEREST. END TEXT. WHITEHEAD
