MARCH 27, 1980

DEAR MADAME PRIME MINISTER:

IN ADDITION TO CONSIDERING WHAT NEXT STEPS WE SHOULD TAKE IN THE IRANIAN CRISIS, ABOUT WHICH I MOTE YOU EARLIER THIS WEEK, I HAVE BEEN REFLECTING ON HOW WE IN NATO MIGHT BEST ASSURE THAT THE ALLIANCE IS UNITED, STRONG AND CREDIBLE AS IT RESPONDS TO THE SOVIET OCCUPATION OF AFGHANISTAN AND TO MOSCOWAS CLOBAL CHALLENG IN THE 1982&S. I WANT TO SHARE WITH YOU MY THOUGHTS AND SEEK YOUR COUNSEL, AND THAT OF MELMUT SCHMIDT, BEFORE I CONTACT ANY OTHER ALLIED LEADERS.

AS YOU AND I HAVE AGREED FROM THE BEGINNING, THE SOVIET ITVASION OF AFGHANISTAN COMPRONTS THE WEST AND THE NORTH ATLANTIC ALLIANCE WITH A SERIOUS CHALLENGE. THAT IS WHY IT IS SO IMPORTANT FOR THE ALLIED REACTION TO BE COPERENT, MEASURED AND CONCRETE. ALTHOUGH WE HAWE MADE SOME PROGREES IN BEACHING A POINT WHERE COPREACTIONS ARE TANGIBLE AS WELL AS RHETORICAL, A GOOD DEAL REMAINS TO BE DONE REFORE OUR COLLECTIVE RESPONSE IS COMPLETELY CLEAR AND WILL HAVE SUFFICIENT DETERRENT VALUE IN THE KREMLIN. AT THE SAME TIME, IT WOULD BE DAKAGING TO ALL OF US IF THE AFGMANISTAN CRISIS WERE TO BRING ABOUT DISSENTION IN THE WEST — AMONG THE UNITED STATES AND OUR FRIENDS AND ALLIES. I AM DETERMINED TO DO ALL I CAY TO AVOID SUCH TRANSATIANTIC DISCORD.

I WOULD APPRECIATE YOUR ADVICE ON THE IDEA OF HOLDING A NATO SUMMIT IN LATE MAY. WE WOULD BE PREPARED TO OFFER WASHINGTON AS A SITE IF EVERYONE AGREED. ALTERNATIVELY, WE COULD MEET IN LATE JUNE EITHER IN BRUSSELS OR IN ITALY AT THE TIME OF THE VENICE SUMMIT. SUCH A MEETING, IF PROPERLY PREPARED, WOULD GIVE A VITAL AND TANGIBLE DEMONSTRATION OF MESTERN SCLIDARITY AND MILL TO RESIST SOVIET AGGRESSION IN THE AFTERMATH OF AFCHANISTAN. PROPER PREPARATION WOULD BE MECESSARY BECAUSE NATO HEADS OF GOVERNMENT SHOULD NOT CET TOGETHER IF TO DO SO MOULD ONLY REVEAL SERIOUS DIVISION AND MEAKNESS AMONG US. I WOULD CONSIDER IT BOTH REALISTIC AND CONVINCING IF ALLIED LEADERS COULD ASREE ON A PACKAGE OF MEASURES AT A NATO SUMMIT MEETING WHICH, AT A MINIMUM, WOULD:
