PRIME MINISTER'S VISIT TO CHINA

I refer to your letter dated 25 August asking for assistance on a number of points concerning the China part of the trip.

1. I enclose 12 photographs and a biography of the Prime Minister.

2. As far as the cultural performance is concerned, the Prime Minister takes an interest in most aspects of a country's culture and the suggestions given in Peking Tel. 459 of 24 August - opera, song and dance, acrobatics and any other suitable activities are acceptable.

3. Both the Prime Minister and Mr. Thatcher normally have the following for breakfast:-

Fresh orange juice  
Coffee  
Toast  
Marmalade/confiture  
Scrambled or poached eggs

4. We discussed the protocol order of the party on the telephone.

5. Mr. Thatcher also takes an interest in most aspects of culture and enjoys most sports.
