## Government Changes

The minimum number of changes which must be made, following your decision to create a Department of Energy, is as follows:-

Lord Carrington to be Secretary of State for Energy

Joe Godber to be Secretary of State for Defence

Ian Gilmour to be Minister of Agriculture, and to enter the Cabinet George Younger to be Minister of State for Defence

Hamish Gray to be Under Secretary of State for Scotland

Patrick Jenkin to be Minister of State, Department of Energy

Tom Boardman to be Chief Secretary to the Treasury

David Howell to be Minister of State, Department of Energy

Peter Emery to be Under Secretary of State, Department of Energy

This arrangement would be possible only if a Minister of State vacancy can be secured. I suggest therefore that Lord Drumalbyn should retire and that Lord Aberdare should be appointed Minister without Portfolio and not be replaced at Minister of State level at DHSS.

Three other matters arise:-

 You wish <u>Eldon Griffiths</u> to be given responsibility for dealing with the planning back log. This he can do in his present Department but must remain in his present rank as there is no room for more Ministers of State. His existing functions can be done by <u>Hugh Rossi</u> to be Under Secretary of State, Department of the Environment.

- 2. Tony Royle wishes to retire. His place can be filled as follows:
  Peter Blaker to be Under Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs

  Lord Strathcona and Mount Royal to be Under Secretary of State for the Army
- Tony Kershaw would make way. If you accept his offer to do so, which I recommend, it would enable you to promote one back bencher, Nicholas Scott..

The appointments would be :-

<u>Nicholas Scott</u> to be Under Secretary of State, Department of Employment
