ISRAEL/LEBANON: EXTENSION OF UNIFIL MANDATE

1. US EMBASSY HAS APPROACHED US ON INSTRUCTIONS FOR UK SUPPORT FOR A QUOTE SIMPLE, PROCEDURAL RESOLUTION UNQUOTE THAT WOULD RENEW UNIFIL'S MANDATE FOR 90 DAYS, WITHOUT ATTEMPTING TO DEFINE THE FUTURE OF UNIFIL. THE AMERICANS ARE ASKING THAT THERE MUST BE NO EFFORT TO USE SUCH A RESOLUTION TO CONDEMN ISRAEL, OR OTHERWISE POLITICISE THE RESOLUTION IN A WAY THAT COULD JEOPARDISE ITS ADOPTION, OR TO PRE-DETERMINE ELEMENTS OF A SETTLEMENT IN LEBANON NOT ALREADY PROVIDED IN RESOLUTIONS 508 AND 509. THEY SEE THE ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS OF A RESOLUTION AS BEING:

- (A) REAFFIRMATION OF RESOLUTIONS 508 AND 509;
- (B) A COMMITMENT TO LEBANON'S SOVEREIGNTY AND TERRITORIAL INTEGRITY;
- (C) A REFERENCE TO RESOLUTION 425;
- (D) EXTENSION OF UNIFIL'S MANDATE FOR 90 DAYS.

2. WHILE THERE ARE ASPECTS OF AMERICAN POLICY ABOUT WHICH WE HAVE OUR DOUBTS. IT IS CLEARLY SENSIBLE TO PRESERVE THE OPTION OF A UN-BASED PEACEKEEPING FORCE FOR THE NEW SITUATION IN SOUTH LEBANON. WE THEREFORE AGREE WITH THE AMERICAN PROPOSAL THAT A SIMPLE RESOLUTION IS A SENSIBLE WAY TO PROCEED. INDICATIONS ARE (YOUR TELNO 987) THAT THE USSR MIGHT GO ALONG WITH A SIMPLE EXTENSION FOR A MONTH OR SO. NO DOUBT THE AMERICANS WOULD ACCEPT LESS THAN 90 DAYS AS BEING PREFERABLE TO A SOVIET VETO. UNLESS YOU SEE OBJECTION, WE SHOULD BE GRATEFUL IF YOU COULD PROCEED ACCORDINGLY.

3. FOR PARIS. PLEASE CHECK WITH THE FRENCH WHETHER THEY HAVE
