SUBJECT: State's Recommended Guest List for Thatcher Dinner

In the interests of saving time, and with the help of Don Gregg's example on the Chun lunch, we are giving you State's recommended list of invitees for the Thatcher dinner in fairly raw form, (Tab A), i.e., with pencilled suggestions for change. The check-marks indicate possible candidates for deletion, and the page at the end incorporates your personal suggestions for additions (I have also question-marked a number of names on State's list which seem to me to fall into the "desirable but not indispensable" category). Lyn Nofziger is checking a copy from a domestic political standpoint and Max Friedersdorf is vetting the Congressional category. With their recommendations, together with your approved version, it will be no problem to do a quick and definitive retype for forwarding.

At Tab B, FYI is the list of invitees for the return dinner at the British Embassy which the Brits shared with us. I have assurances from the people there that they will be happy to add to this list a number of names which the White House might be desirous of including. If you can give me some suggestions, I will ensure that the Brits get them in good order (on a very discreet and informal basis I am also sharing our tentative - repeat tentative - list with a senior British Embassy type to make sure we avoid the misfortunes of past years, i.e., the inclusion of any invitees who might, unbeknownst to us, be anathema to Mrs. Thatcher).

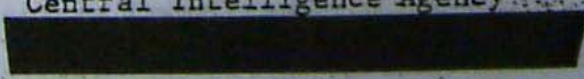
