Dear Mr Alexander,

I have been asked by my Prime Minister to transmit the following message to Mrs Margaret Thatcher:

Message begins:

"THANK YOU FOR YOUR MESSAGE (.) YOUR POSITION
ON ZIMBABWE-RHODESIA HAS BEEN CONSISTENT AND
CLEAR CUT (.) I HAVE FOLLOWED THE PROGRESS OF
THE RHODESIAN CONFERENCE AT LANCASTER HOUSE,
AND AM HEARTENED TO LEARN THAT THE RHODESIAN
CONFERENCE HAS REACHED AN ALL-PARTY AGREEMENT
ON THE BRITISH PROPOSALS FOR A TRANSITIONAL PERIOD
LEADING TO INDEPENDENCE (.)

IT IS MY HOPE THAT THERE WILL BE A PEACEFUL SETTLEMENT TO THE RHODESIAN PROBLEM (.) "
