FALKLANDS

- 1. The Captain of the RRS Bransfield, a British Antartic survey vessel in the Falkland Islands, has reported that he has intercepted local Falkland Island radio broadcasts which say that 200 Argentinians have landed in armoured troop carriers (presumably but not confirmed by sea); that 3 Argentinian ships are anchored in Fort William, the outer harbour of Fort Stanley, and that as far as is known there have not yet been any casualties. The Commander of the Argentine unit is reported to be attempting to contact the Governor, as yet without success.
- 2. We must accept this as confirmation of an Argentine landing.
