YOUR TELNO 199: ECONOMIC MEASURES AGAINST ARGENTINA
1. Please pass the following message from the Prime Minister to Mr Trudeau.
BEGINS
I have just learned about the decision taken by your Government yesterday to ban all imports from Argentina and to cut off export credit finance. I am deeply grateful for this action. Together with the steps taken by our other friends and allies across the world these measures will certainly contribute to the pressure on the Argentina government to withdraw from the Falkland Islands and to agree to a peaceful settlement in accordance with Security Council Resolution No 502. I am most heartened by your support.
