SUBJECT: Morning Developments

Lebanon/Israel/Syria

President Sarkis today announced the formation of a "National Salvation Board" to help the government deal with the 25X1 current crisis situation. NESA Comment: Sarkis likely is moving to establish a government of national unity in order to prevent any attempt by Tel Aviv to install an Israeli-fashioned government. 25X1 25X1 reports that Syria has suffered over 600 KIA, 200 to 250 tanks destroyed, and annroximately 100 MIG-21 and MIG-22 aircraft shot down. 25X1 25X1 about 1,500 trantan troops arrived in Syria on 12 June. The following morning. 400 to 500 of this aroun renortedly went into Lebanon. 25X1 reported the arrival of approximately 1,000 Iranians in Syria, and noted that a total of 30,000 Iranian troops were expected to arrive by 20 June.

Falk lands

President Galtieri--in a message to Pope John Paul--today said that Argentina is ready to accept an immediate cease-fire followed by a swift and mutual withdrawal of forces. (Reuter)

Working Group Comment: This message represents no change from other public statements, but Galtieri's reiteration of a ceasefire proposal may indicate a growing willingness to end the fighting. With victory in sight, Prime Minister Thatcher is likely to reject any plan that does not provide for a unilateral Argentine withdrawal.
