SUBJECT: Call on You by Lord Carrington (U)

State's memorandum (Tab A) makes a convincing case for you to receive UK Foreign Secretary Peter Carrington during the visit of Prime Minister Thatcher. State stresses Carrington's interest in developing a working relationship with you, and I concur in the importance of that objective. Carrington's support (and restraint) will be critical in a number of key international issues likely to involve some of our major interests over the next few months (e.g., Middle East) and for that reason I believe it will be useful if you can meet him during the specific time he has requested (February 27 at 11:45 a.m.). (C)

That you meet with Lord Carrington on February 27 at 11:45 a.m. (U)
