THE VITAL SECURITY INTERESTS OF THE NATIONS OF WESTERN EUROPE ARE ESSENTIALLY IDENTICAL. THOSE SHARED INTERESTS ARE INCREASINGLY FINDING EXPRESSION AS OUR RESPONSE TO EVENTS IN AFGHANISTAN DEVELOPS. THE JOINT COMMUNIQUE AGREED BY YOU AND HELMUT SCHMIDT LAST WEEK, LIKE THE PRINCIPLES OUTLINED BY PETER CARRINGTON AT THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS' MEETING ON 5 FEBRUARY, IS AN IMPORTANT ELEMENT IN A PROCESS WHICH WILL, I HOPE, BE CARRIED FURTHER AT THE MEETING OF THE NINE IN ROME ON 19 FEBRUARY.
