YOUR TELNO 1098: FALKLANDS

1. I SAW HAIG JUST BEFORE HIS DEPARTURE FOR EUROPE WITH THE PRESIDENT. HE WAS VERY WORKED UP ABOUT SOME OF THE PRESS THINGS THAT HAVE BEEN APPEARING, PARTICULARLY IN THE UK, ALLEGING THAT HE IS QUOTE WET UNQUOTE AND TRYING TO DISSUADE THE BRITISH FROM ACHIEVING WHAT THEY THINK ARE THEIR PROPER MILITARY OBJECTIVES. HE SEES THE HAND OF HELMS AND CARBOUGH, NOT TO MENTION JEANE KIRKPATRICK, IN THESE MACHINATIONS.

2. THANKS TO YOUR TELEGRAM UNDER REFERENCE CONVEYING GENEROUS APPRECIATION OF AMERICAN SUPPORT AND THE VALUE OF THE DIALOGUE, I WAS ABLE TO REASSURE HAIG THAT YOU WERE FULLY AWARE OF HIS STALWARTNESS ON THE FUNDAMENTAL ISSUES. HE WAS MUCH RELIEVED BY THE MESSAGE SINCE HE CONSIDERS THAT HE HAS LENT OVER BACKWARDS FOR US AND QUOTE RESENTS BITTERLY UNQUOTE, TO USE HIS OWN WORDS, THE CURRENT CRITICISMS.

3. I AM SURE THAT HE WAS SUITABLY AND ADEQUATELY ASSUAGED BY YOUR MESSAGE.

4. THE MESSAGE IN YOUR TELNO 1098 HAS ALSO BEEN PASSED TO THE PRESIDENT.

YOUR TELNO 1101: BILATERAL WITH REAGAN

1. THE AMBASSADOR WAS ABLE TO PASS THIS MESSAGE TO DEEVER ON BOARD PRESIDENT REAGAN'S AIRCRAFT. THE WHITE HOUSE HAVE SUBSEQUENTLY CONFIRMED THAT THE PRESIDENT LOOKS FORWARD TO SEEING THE PRIME MINISTER IN PARIS AT 1500 ON 4 JUNE. WE UNDERSTAND THAT THE MEETING WILL BE HELD AT THE US RESIDENCE.
