we must arrange a meeting soon.

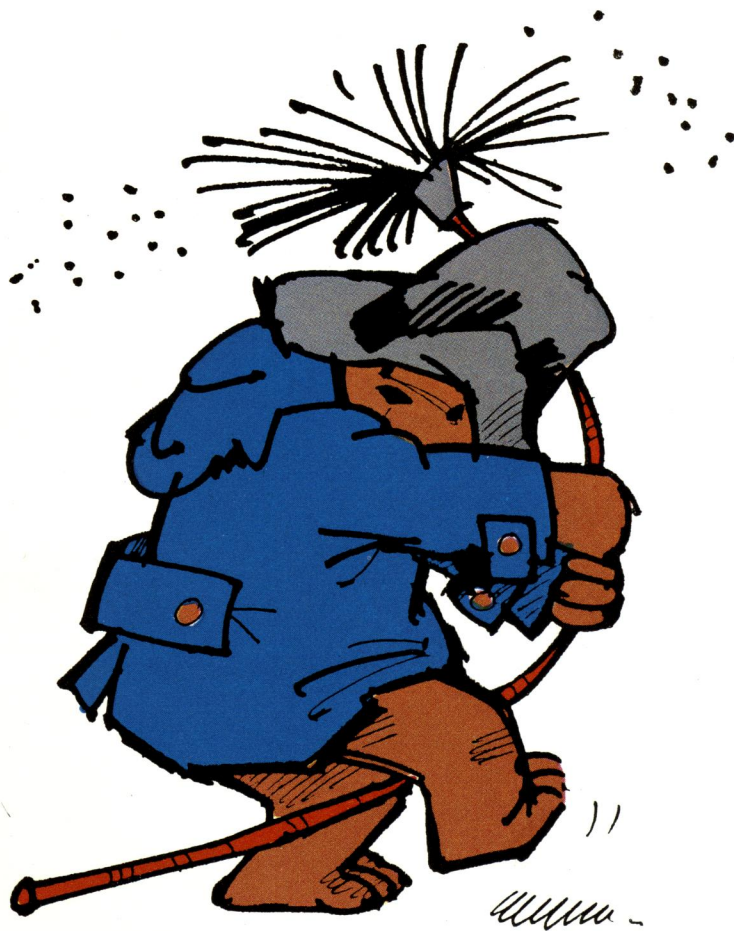
