2. THE SECRETARY SAID WE NOW HAVE BASIC INTELLIGENCE CON-FIRMING THAT IT IS CUBAN/SOVIET STRATEGY TO SUBVERT ALL OF CENTRAL AMERICA. THEY ARE SUPPORTING INSURGENTS IN HONDURAS AND BUATEMALA AND ULTIMATELY IN MEXICO. - S. CARRINGTON NOTED THE UK STATEMENT CONDEMNING ANY ARMS BEING SUPPLIED TO THE GUERRILLA MOVEMENT. HOMEVER, BRITAIN COULD NOT BLESS THE PRESENT SALVADORAN GOVERNMENT.
- 4. THE SECRETARY EXPRESSED US GRATITUDE FOR THE MANNER IN WHICH BRITAIN HAD STUCK ITS NECK GUT IN SUPPORT OF THE AMERICAN POSITION. AT A MEETING WITH THE PRESS EARLIER IN THE DAY, HE HAD MADE SEVERAL OBSERVATIONS. THE FIRST WAS THAT HE HAD TO DEAL EFFECTIVELY WITH EXTERNAL SUBVERSION
