Thank you for your kind letter of
January 17 about Vladimir Bukovsky.

I too had heard that he wants to
settle in Britain and in view of the fact
that Alexander Solzhenitsyn is already
living in the United States and Andrei
Amalrik eventually intends taking up
residence there, I think that it is vital
for us to help Bukovsky find a place at
one of our own Universities. As you may
know Keith Joseph did a great deal last
year by way of sounding out one or two
Universities on Amalrik's behalf. More
recently my Office have discreetly spoken
to Keith's about the possibility of similar
efforts being made for Bukovsky and I
understand that discussions are taking place
although Bukovsky himself is at present in
Holland.

* I am forwarding copies of our correspondence
to Keith Joseph in the absolute knowledge that
he will do everything possible for Bukovsky.
