SUBJECT: Response to Senator Kennedy's Letter
on Northern Ireland

At Tab B is a letter to you from Senator Kennedy asking you to raise the subject of Northern Ireland with Mrs. Thatcher in Tokyo; the tone of his letter suggests that you had expressed some willingness to do so.

I attach a response to Kennedy. It incorporates a polite reiteration of our August 30, 1977 policy statement on Northern Ireland, stressing the U. S. need to remain impartial.

The Speechwriter's Office has cleared it. CL concurs.
