We are endeavouring to find common ground with thinking people in or associated with the Labour movement. I enclose a short paper on our concept of the common ground. We hope to work through seminars and publications. Our first seminar will be based on an article by Professor John Vaizey "The Roulette of Public Spending" in the NEW STATESMAN of February 18th, instead of commissioning a special paper. He will introduce it as he would a previously circulated paper. We shall have discussants to take up various points, not necessarily to disagree, but, where they agree, to trace the implications and further questions raised by them.
