ECONOMIC SUMMIT.

1. FOLLOWING IS TEXT OF MESSAGE FROM THE PRIME MINISTER TO PRESIDENT CARTER, WHICH PLEASE DELIVER AT THE EARLIEST OPPORTUNTIY.

BEGINS:

DEAR MR PRESIDENT,

VERY MANY THANKS FOR YOUR LETTER OF 12 FEBRUARY ABOUT VICE-PRES-IDENT MONDALE'S RECENT VISIT HERE - WHICH I GREATLY VALUED - AND ABOUT THE PROSPECT OF A FURTHER SUMMIT MEETING OF THE HEADS OF STATE AND GOVERNMENT OF THE INDUSTRIALISED DEMOCRACIES.

I AM GLAD TO HEAR THAT THE VICE-PRESIDENT FOUND A GENERAL CONSENSUS ON HIS RECENT TRIP THAT SUCH A MEETING WOULD BE USEFUL, AND THAT IT SHOULD BE HELD IN LONDON IN THE FIRST HALF OF MAY. AS YOU KNOW, I TOO SEE VALUE IN ANOTHER MEETING OF THIS KIND AND AT THIS TIME: AND I WOULD BE HAPPY FOR THE UNITED KINGDOM TO TAKE ON THE HOST COUNTRY RESPONSIBILITIES AS YOU SUGGEST. YOU SUGGESTED THAT THE DEST TIMING MIGHT BE JUST BEFORE THE NATO MINISTERIAL MEETING ON 10/11 MAY, THIS IS CERTAINLY ACCEPTABLE TO ME, AND I WOULD LIKE TO SUGGEST 7-8 MAY. I HOPE THAT THIS WILL BE ACCEPTABLE TO YOU.

I NOTE THAT YOU FORESEE PARTICIPATION BY THOSE COUNTRIES REPRESENTED AT PUERTO RICO, BUT THAT YOU WOULD WELCOME PARTICIP-ATION BY THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY. AS YOU SAY, THE NATURE OF COMMUN-ITY REPRESENTATION IS SOMETHING WHICH WE AND THE OTHER COMMUNITY COUNTRIES MUST NOW DISCUSS. AS THE CURRENT PRESIDENT, I SHALL NOW SET THIS DISCUSSION IN TRAIN SEMI CLN AND I WILL BE IN TOUCH WITH YOU AGIAN, PROBABLY EARLY NEXT MONTH, WHEN OUR DISCUSSIONS ON THIS POINT HAVE TAKEN PLACE, WE CAN THEN ALSO CONSIDER DETAILED

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QUESTIONS OF AGENDA AND PREPARATORY ARRANGEMENTS. I FULLY AGREE
WITH YOU ON THE NEED FOR CAREFUL PREPARATION AND I AM GRATEFUL
TO YOU FOR YOUR MESSAGE OF 18 FEBRUARY INFORMING ME THAT YOU HAV
APPOINTED HENRY OWEN AS YOUR PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE PREPARATORY WORK. I HAVE ASKED SIR JOHN HUNT TO ACT AS MY PERSONAL
REPRESENTATIVE FOR THIS PURPOSE.

I ALSO WELCOME WHAT YOU SAY ABOUT DISCREET POLITICAL DISCUSSIONS BETWEEN THE FOUR OF US WITH BERLIN RESPONSIBILITIES, AND I
HOPE THAT IT MIGHT BE POSSIBLE FOR US TO MEET PRIVATELY FOR THIS
PURPOSE ON THE EVENING BEFORE THE MAIN MEETING BEGINS. IF THIS WAS
AGREEABLE TO YOU, I WOULD SUGGEST TO PRESIDENT GISCARD AND
CHANCELLOR SCHMIDT THAT WE MIGHT START THESE DISCUSSIONS ON THE
AFTERNOON OF 6 MAY.

FOR THE TIME BEING, WE SHALL DEFER ANY AMNOUNCEMENTS HERE ABOUT THE PRECISE ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE MEETING.

I VERY MUCH LOOK FORWARD TO DISCUSSING THIS -- AND MANY OTHER SUBJECTS OF INTEREST TO US BOTH -- DURING MY VISIT TO WASHINGTON NEXT MONTH.
