MESSAGE FROM PRESIDENT TOLBERT: RHODESIA

1. PLEASE PASS FOLLOWING MESSAGE FROM THE PRIME MINISTER TO PRESIDENT TOLBERT. BEGINS .

- THANK YOU FOR YOUR MESSAGE ABOUT RHODESIA, WHICH I HAVE CON-SIDERED VERY CAREFULLY.
- DURING THE CONSITUTIONAL CONFERENCE. LORD CARRINGTON GAVE AN ASSURANCE THAT THERE WOULD BE NO EXTERNAL INTERVENTION OR INVOLVE-MENT IN RHODESIA UNDER THE GOVERNOR.
- 3. WE DO NOT BELIEVE THAT THE PRESENCE OF A SOUTH AFRICAN CON-TINGENT TO GUARD BEITBRIDGE ON THE BORDER CONSTITUTES INTERVENTION THE FORCE IS SMALL AND IS PRESENT SOLELY FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE BRIDGE, WHICH, AS YOU KNOW, IS OF VITAL IMPORTANCE TO THE ECONOMIES OF RHODESIA AND OF NEIGHBOURING COUNTRIES. THE BRIDGE IS HALF SOUTH AFRICAN PROPERTY. DAMAGE TO IT WOULD HAVE VERY SERIOUS CONSEQUENCS TO SEVERAL COUNTRIES IN THE REGION. A TEAM FROM THE COMMONWEALTH MONITORING FORCE PRESENT AT BEITBRIDGE AND I AM SATISFIED THAT THIS GIVES US SUFFICIENT ASSURANCE THAT THE ROLE OF THE SOUTH AFRICAN CONTINGENT THERE WILL BE LIMITED TO THE PROTECTION OF THE BRIDGE. I CAN ALSO ASSURE YOU THAT THE GOVERNOR WILL KEEP THE NEED FOR THIS SPECIAL MEASURE OF PROTECTION UNDER REVIEW. IN THE LIGHT OF THESE FACTS, I HOPE THAT YOU WILL AGREE THAT AN EXCEPTIONAL MEASURE TO PROTECT A VITAL FEATURE ON THE BORDER BETWEEN RHODESIA AND SOUTH AFRICA DOES NOT AMOUNT TO EXTERNAL INVOLVEMENT IN RHODESIA.

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I SHARE YOUR DESIRE TO SEE THE AGREEMENTS NEGOTIATED AT I AM SURE THAT YOU LANCASTER HOUSE SUCCESSFULLY IMPLEMENTED. WILL AGREE THAT REMARKABLE PROGRESS HAS BEEN MADE. BUT IT IS ESSENTIAL THAT ALL PARTIES SHOULD COMPLY WITH THE TERMS OF THE AGREEMENTS WHICH HAVE BEEN SIGNED: IN THIS RESPECT WE ARE VERY CONCERNED ABOUT THE CONTINUING AND SERIOUS BREACHES OF THE CEASEFIRE WHICH HAVE BEEN COMMITTED, MOSTLY BY ZANLA FORCES. THEIR ACTIVITIES ARE NOT COMPATIBLE EITHER WITH THE CEASEFIRE AGREEMENT ITSELF OR WITH THE UNDERTAKING SIGNED BY ALL THE DELEGATIONS AT LANCASTER HOUSE TO RENOUNCE THE USE OF FORCE AND TO CAMPAIGN WITHOUT INTIMIDATION. I HOPE YOU WILL FEEL ABLE TO URGE ON THOSE CONCERNED THE NEED TO ABIDE BY THE AGREEMENTS. I HOPE THAT YOU WILL KEEP ME CLOSELY IN TOUCH WITH YOUR VIEWS, WHICH I VALUE GREATLY. YOUR COOPERATION AND ADVICE WAS A MAJOR CONTRIBUTION TO THE SUCCESS OF THE CONFERENCE. MAY I WISH YOU. ALSO, MR PRESIDENT, A VERY HAPPY AND PROSPEROUS NEW YEAR.
